Protected Side of Investment

Direct Purchase of Oil & Gas!

Invest in currently producing Oil & Gas at a wholesale price and sell it at a retail price. This provides approximately 15% to 25% annualized cash - on -cash return.

At an average rate of 20% annualized return each year this accumulates enough income to cover all of your risks on your advanced side of investing.



In the past only multi million dollar large investors would have the opportunity to invest in currently producing wells.

Advance Side of Investment

(Investment can vary)

Project Types

Very Low Risk -- No Drilling Risk!

Well work-over projects * Putting wells back online * Moving up-hole for additional pay zones*

Medium Risk -- Developmental Wells

(Wells offsetting other successful wells) * 85% success * 25% to 100% Annualized Return on Investment.

High Risk -- Exploratory Wells

(Wildcats) 10% success rate with a possible 100 to one Return-on-Investment.

This side of your investment portfolio is designed to create higher revenues and is the cash flow engine to reinvest in other projects. Your decisions of which project you decide on should be based on your current position. Otherwise, your initial investments should be on the low risk side to insure your overall success. You should re-invest some of your profits in your Secured Side, thereby protecting your Advanced Side.
